

MTA 3.0 INTRODUCTION

To better serve biobanks and find the most suitable support strategy to help researchers access and use biological resources (i.e. biological material and data) in a more easy and effective manner, SBP has revised its MTA templates (v1.0 and 2.0) to propose only one single template (MTA 3.0) which now includes different options and guidance depending if you share or not personal data.

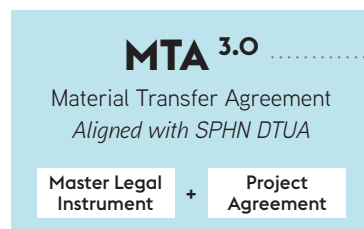
The contractual setup contains two separate documents:

- **the Project Agreement (PA)**, which needs to be filled in for each project and contains mostly operative provisions; and
- **the Master Legal Instrument (MLI)**, which contains the legal provisions applicable between the parties that will not be amended (unless the PA provides for an exception).

This new template is fully aligned with the latest version of the SPHN DTUA and refers to it when applicable.

In parallel, SBP has participated to the revision of the SPHN Consortium Agreement which now includes a DTUA, DTPA and a MTA schedule aligned with the new version of SBP MTA v3.0.

Transfer of biological material and (personal) data

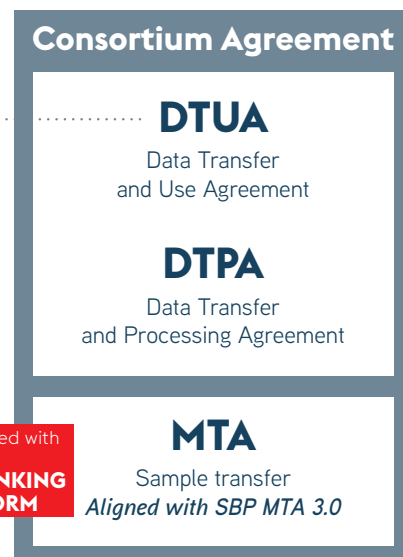
